

# Making and answering calls

# Answering calls

### Answering calls using the handset

When your telephone rings, or flashes beside an intercom or line key:

Lift the handset.

#### 0R

Press the key beside the flashing before lifting the handset.

### Answering calls using Handsfree

When your telephone rings, or flashes beside an intercom or line key:

1. Press Handsfree

# Making calls

Depending upon the dialling mode programmed on your telephone, you may have to lift your handset before making a call.

Line 1

Intercom

### External calls using numbered line keys

- 1. If you do not have an external Prime line, press a line key.
- Dial your call.

### External calls using intercom keys

- 1. Lift the handset.
- 2. If appears beside an intercom key, enter a line pool access code. OR
- Press an intercom key without , then enter a line pool access code.

  3. When you hear external dial tone, dial your call.

### Internal calls using intercom keys

- If you do not have an internal Prime line, press Intercom
- 2. Dial your call.

**Note:** Line pool access codes and extension numbers are supplied by your System Coordinator.

# Making calls using Handsfree

Press Handsfree instead of lifting the handset.

Hold

## Holding Calls

- Press Hold . The Islands beside the line on hold.
- 2. Press the line key with the flashing to return to the call.

### Automatic hold

Calls are put on hold automatically when you switch from one line to another.

#### Exclusive hold

Use Exclusive Hold (Feature Hold ) to keep a call on hold private.

Handsfree

This key operates your telephone's built-in microphone and speaker. Your System Coordinator can program Handsfree for your telephone.

# Switching between Handsfree and handset


- 1. Press Handsfree and replace the handset to switch to Handsfree.
- 2. Pick up the handset to switch back.

### Using Mute

- 1. Press Handsfree to turn the microphone OFF.
- 2. Press Handsfree again to turn the microphone ON.

# Programming memory keys

# About memory keys



Memory keys store telephone numbers or feature codes to give you one-touch dialling or feature activation.

There are two types of memory keys: single-memory and dual-memory.

### Dual-memory keys

To use the **bottom** function, press the dual-memory key.
To use the **top** function, press the shift key, then press the dual-memory key.

# Single-memory keys

Single-memory keys are the keys with indicators other than line or Handsfree keys.

Remember: Press Feature \* 0 to check a memory or line key.

# Programming memory keys

#### External autodial

- 2. Press Feature \* 1 .
- 3. Press a memory key.
- 4. Dial the external number.
- 5. Press <u>OK</u> to store the number.
- 6. Label your new key.

### Internal autodial

- If you are on a call or an open line with dial tone, press

  Hold Or Ris .
- 2. Press Feature \* 2
- 3. Press a memory key.
- 4. Dial the extension number.
- Label your new key.

#### Features

- If you are on a call or an open line with dial tone, press

  Hold Or Ris .
- 2. Press Feature \* 3 .
- 3. Press a memory key.
- Press Feature and the feature code.
- 5. Label your new key.

# Erasing memory keys

If you are on a call or an open line with dial tone, press

Hold Or Ris .

- 2. Press Feature \* 1
- Press the memory key you want to erase.
- 4. Press <u>OK</u> to erase the key.
