



## Avaya 4612 IP Telephone

The 4612 is an IP telephone with 12 programmable line and feature buttons, a two line LCD display and a full duplex speakerphone. The display informs the user of date, time, call timer, calling party information and access to state dependent user features. Feature and line appearance buttons have a red and a green LED associated with each to indicate line states and feature status. The 4612 works with the DEFINITY® and IP600 Communication Servers, part of the Enterprise Class IP Solutions (ECLIPS) portfolio.
