
OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- NEVER INSTALL TELEPHONE WIRING DURING A LIGHTNING STORM.
- NEVER INSTALL TELEPHONE JACKS IN WET LOCATIONS, UNLESS THE JACK IS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR WET LOCATIONS.
- NEVER TOUCH UNINSULATED TELEPHONE WIRES OR TERMINALS, UNLESS THE TELEPHONE LINE HAS BEEN DISCONNECTED AT THE NETWORK INTERFACE.
- DO NOT PLACE THIS PRODUCT ON AN UNSTABLE CART, STAND OR TABLE. THE PRODUCT MAY FALL, CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE PRODUCT.

2. INSTALLATION

- CONNECT THE TELEPHONE LINE CORD TO THE LINE JACK (RJ11C) (1). TO ENSURE PROPER CONNECTION, PRESS THE LOCKING TAB FIRMLY INTO THE MODULAR JACK UNTIL A “CLICK” SOUND IS HEARD.



3. ADJUSTMENT

- SET THE PHONE TO EITHER TONE OR PULSE SYSTEM (3) THAT YOUR TELEPHONE SERVICES COMPANY SUPPORTS
- SET THE RINGER VOLUME LEVER SELECTOR (4) TO ON (WITH SOUNDS) OR OFF TO YOUR OWN PREFERENCE.

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4. OPERATION

MAKING CALLS:

- REMOVE THE RECEIVER FROM THE CRADLE.
- PRESS THE NUMERICAL BUTTON TO DIAL THE DESIRED NUMBERS.

RECEIVING CALL:

- WHEN THERE IS AN INCOMING CALL, LIFT THE RECEIVER FROM THE CRADLE AND TALK INTO THE MOUTHPIECE TO BEGIN YOUR CONVERSATION.
- TO TERMINATE THE CONVERSATION, REPLACE THE RECEIVER BACK IN THE CRADLE
