- 2. An active Internet connection.
- Access to the Internet via an Ethernet port on your router or modem.
 Note: You may use the OBi302 as a router by connecting the OBi302 directly to your broadband modem.
- (Optional but very useful) An Internet phone service subscription with all required username and password credentials.

2 Polycom OBi302 Installation

Please observe the following steps to install the OBi.

- A. Connect a phone to the green **PHONE 1** port. Use cable currently connected to phone. Note: An optional second phone or fax machine can be used with the Phone 2 port.
- B. Connect one end of the Ethernet cable to the blue **INTERNET** port and the other end to an Ethernet port on your Internet router, broadband modem or Ethernet switch.
- C. Connect the power adapter to the OBi power jack and a power outlet.

3 Make a Test Call Using Polycom OBiTALK

At any time, you may place a test call to the OBi Number below:

Dial ** 9 followed by:

OBiTALK Test No: **222 222 222**

Your OBi is ready to make FREE calls to other OBi endpoints using the **OBiTALK** network. On the bottom of your unit, you will see a 9-digit OBi Number. This is **your** OBi Number. Give this number to your friends, family and colleagues so they can call you from their OBi device or using the OBiON iPhone and Android apps for smart phones.

To use the **OBITALK** network, all you have to do is install your OBi, pick up the phone and then call your friends by dialing ** **9** and **their** nine-digit OBi Number.



Setup a Polycom OBiTALK Account

Go to: www.obitalk.com

Register for a Polycom OBiTALK account. This will allow you to easily activate devices and add any commercial VoIP services used with your OBi.

The first time you log-in to OBiTALK, a pop-up window will appear allowing you to add your device.

Click "Yes" to add Your OBi Device to the OBiTALK Dashboard. After adding your device, you will be able to set-up voice services and other configuration information. Multiple devices may be added to a single account.

Follow the on-screen instructions to add your OBi device to your OBiTALK account.

Once added, you will be directed to the Device Configuration page.

- Set your OBi display name, time zone, and daylight savings values.
- Select the "Save Changes" button.

5 Set-Up VoIP Services

This OBi device may already be pre-configured by a service provider such that no additional configuration is required beyond the phusical conections in step 2. If you are going to use Bring Your Own Device VoIP serivce credentials, after you register and add your OBi302 device at www.obitalk.com, the OBi Device Configuration page will help you set-up commercial VoIP services. You may select from any one of the other listed service providers, or if your service is not there, you may use the Generic Service Provider option.

Generally, all you will need to set-up a service is the User Name and Password for the service.

Note: You will need to choose what phone port is to be used with the selected service. By default, both phone ports—Phone 1 & Phone 2, will work with the first service you initially configure on your OBi302.

Important: Only an analog telephone or fax machine should be connected to the OBi PHONE port. Do not connect a cable from the PHONE port to a telephone jack powered by the phone company. Doing so may cause damage to the OBi electronics.

How to perform a factory reset:

- 1. Power on the OBi device.
- Locate the Factory Reset button access hole on the bottom of the OBi. It is a circular hole (a little larger than the others) just above and to the left of the Model ID on the product label.
- 3. Using a paper clip or similar instrument, depress the button inside the hole for 15 seconds.
- The Power LED will flash red. This indicates you may release the button and the OBi will now be reset to its factory defaults.

Note: A service provider may restrict some settings from being reset to a factory default.

OBi device manager web page access:

- 1. From a phone attached to the OBi, dial *** to access the OBi config attendant.
- 2. Choose "1" to hear the IP address of the OBi.
- Enter the OBi IP address in a local PC browser web site address window:
